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The 6 hectares that make up Villa Job have been in the Job family for generations. The vineyard is located on the Friuli Pozzuolo plateau. At 90 meters above sea level, it is called 'the Hills' or 'the Terraces' by geologists and is surrounded by forest and the Cormor River. Both Alessandro & Lavinia were working in Milan when they met - he was a business manager/ engineer and she worked in marketing. When Alessandro inherited the land at Villa Job, they decided to return to the land and take the reins of his family's legacy.
