At 90 meters above sea level, it is called 'the Hills' or 'the Terraces' by geologists and is surrounded by forest and the Cormor River. Both Alessandro & Lavinia were working in Milan when they met - he was a business manager/ engineer and she worked in marketing. When Alessandro inherited the land at Villa Job, they decided to return to the land and take the reins of his family's legacy.

REGION: Venezia Giulia, Friuli, Italy

GRAPES: 80% Pinot Grigio, Malvasia (2016), 20% Pinot Grigio (2008-2015)

YEASTS: Native

MACERATION: 80% Pinot Grigio with light maceration in cement

AGING: 80% in cement for 6 months and barrel for another 6 months. Oxidative style in used barrels and 2 months in bottle

CLARIFICATION/FILTRATION: Unfiltered/ Unfined

FARMING: Organic

ALCOHOL CONTENT: 13.5%

SOIL: Marl, clay, silt

VINE AGE: 15 years
