MACERATION: Syrah - 5 days whole cluster, additional 5 days after pressing

on skins. Merlot - 7 days whole cluster

FERMENTATION VESSEL: Stainless steel, bin

AGING: Syrah - 6 months in neutral

barrique, Merlot - 17 months in barrique

CLARIFICATION/FILTRATION: Unfiltered/Unfined

ADDED SO2: 15ppm

FARMING: Organic, dry farmed

ALCOHOL CONTENT: 13%

TOTAL PRODUCTION: 40 cases
