REGION: Lodi, California

GRAPES: 32% Grenache, 29% Prieto Picudo, 29% Mourvedre, 10% Mencia

YEASTS: Ambient

MACERATION: Direct press on Mourvedre, 12 days whole cluster for others

AGED: 7 months in old puncheon and barrique

CLARIFICATION/FILTRATION: Unfiltered, unfined

ADDED SO2: 8ppm, split between post-malo and pre-bottling

FARMING: Biodynamic

SOIL: Sandy loam

ALCOHOL CONTENT: 11.6%

VOLUME: 750mL or 20L Keg
