Winemaker Victor Beau started Domaine Inebriati by borrowing two hectares from his father Christophe Beau of Domaine Beauthorey. The vineyard has been farmed organically and biodynamically since 1994, and Victor has kept the ethos of caring for the land when starting to farm his o located in the Pic Saint Loup appelation, in the northern side of the Languedoc.
