The name Inebriati comes from the Latin [inebriare], meaning “the drunkards”. Winemaker Victor Beau started Domaine Inebriati by borrowing two hectares from his father Christophe Beau of Domaine Beauthorey. The vineyard has been farmed organically and biodynamically since 1994, and Victor has kept the ethos of caring for the land when starting to farm his own grapes. Victor now has six hectares located in the Pic Saint Loup appellation, in the northern side of the Languedoc.
