### MASIA DE LA ROQUA PÈLEC

Located in Olivella, a small town in Massís del Garraf, a mountain range spanning between Barcelona and Tarragona, the winery dates back to 1164. The Mediterranean climate and rich clay/limestone soils make the area ideal for growing olive trees, almond trees, and vines. Jot Camps, the winemaker, comes from a deep lineage of vintners. He cultivates varieties indigenous to the region - parellada, xarel·lo, macabeo, malvasia de sitges, garnatxa negra... - and creates wines that will transport.
